

**Devon County Council (Road from Honiton Road to Pound Corner, Clyst Honiton)
(Traffic Regulation) Order**

Devon County Council make this order in exercise of powers under sections 1, 2, part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers

- 1 This order comes into force on _____ and may be cited as “Devon County Council (Road from Honiton Road to Pound Corner, Clyst Honiton) (Traffic Regulation) Order “
- 2 In this order **goods vehicle** means a motor vehicle or trailer constructed or adapted for use for the carriage or haulage of goods or burden of any description
- 3 Nothing in this order applies to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform
- 4 Save as provided in article 5 no person shall cause or permit a motor vehicle to proceed through the point specified in schedule 1
- 5 Article 4 does not apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
- 6 Save as provided in article 7 no person shall cause or permit a goods vehicle over 7.5 tonnes to proceed in the length of road specified in schedule 2
- 7 Nothing in article 6 prevents any person from causing a goods vehicle to proceed in the specified length of road if the goods vehicle is being used
 - a) for fire, police or ambulance purposes
 - b) in the service of a local authority or statutory undertaker when being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - c) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to the road, the removal of an obstruction to traffic in the road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to roads of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of **electronic communications network** as defined in section 32 of the Communications Act 2003
 - d) to access roads and properties that are solely accessed from the length of road listed in schedule 2
- 8 The orders in schedule 3 are revoked in their entirety

Schedule 1 – Prohibition of Motor Vehicles

Length of road in Clyst Honiton in the district of East Devon

Road from Honiton Road to Pound Corner at a point 3 metres north-west from its junction with Access To Home Farm Buildings

Schedule 2 – Prohibition of Goods Vehicles over 7.5 tonnes

Length of road in Clyst Honiton in the district of East Devon

Road from Honiton Road to Pound Corner from its junction with Road from Blackhorse Lane to Treasbeare Cottages to a point 3 metres north-west from its junction with Access To Home Farm Buildings
