

## Devon County Council (Various Roads, East Devon) (40mph Speed Limit) Order

Devon County Council make this order under sections 82, 83, 84, part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“Act”) and of all other enabling powers

1. This order comes into force \_\_\_\_\_ and may be cited as “Devon County Council (Various Roads, East Devon) (40mph Speed Limit) Order \_\_\_\_\_”
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in schedule 1
3. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011
4. The orders in schedule 2 are revoked as indicated

### SCHEDULE 1: **40 miles per hour speed limit**

*Lengths of road in the district of East Devon*

**A376 EXMOUTH ROAD** from a point 267 metres north of its junction with Courtlands Lane in Lypstone to a point approximately 160 metres south of its junction with Station Road in Exton

**DINAN WAY LINK** from a point 35 metres east of its junction with Exmouth Road to a point 35 metres west of its junction with Hulham Road
