

Devon County Council (Various Streets, Chagford) (Waiting Restrictions) Amendment Order

Devon County Council propose to make this under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce in Chagford:

No Waiting At Any Time on a specified length of Berry Lane, Drift Way, Ellis Drive, Hares Close, High Street, Lamb Park, Lower Street, Manor Drive, Manor Road, Meldon Road, Mill Street, Nattadon Road, New Street, Orchard Meadow, Prouse Avenue, Road From Lower Street To Crossways Cross, Road From Meldon Road To Weddicott Cross, Road From St Michaels Church To Higher Middlecott Farm, Road From Woodcote To Library, Southcombe Street, Stannary Place, The Acre, The Square, Tinnars Lane, Turnlake Road and Valley View;

Revocation of **No Waiting At Any Time** on specified lengths of Bretteville Close, Lamb Park, Lower Street, Manor Road, Meldon Road, Mill Street, New Street, Road from St Michaels Church to Higher Middlecott Farm, Road from Woodcote to Library, Southcombe Street, The Acre and Valley View;

No Loading At Any Time on a specified length of High Street, Mill Street, New Street, Road From St Michaels Church To Higher Middlecott Farm, Southcombe Street and The Square.

Revocation of **No Loading At Any Time** on a specified length of Lower Street;

Limited Waiting Mon-Sat 9am-5pm 2 Hours No Return Within 4 Hours on a specified length of High Street, Mill Street, Road From St Michaels Church To Higher Middlecott Farm and The Square;

Disabled Badge Holders Only Mon-Sat 9am-5pm Maximum Stay 2 Hours on a specified length of The Square;

Loading Only Mon-Sat 9am-5pm Max Stay 30 Mins on specified lengths of High Street, Mill Street and The Square;

Buses Only At Any Time on a specified length of Lamb Park and Road From Lower Street To Crossways Cross;

Where appropriate there will be the usual exemptions including those in relation to picking up/setting down passengers, loading/unloading goods and disabled persons vehicles.

Statement of reasons

The scheme aims to address longstanding parking issues in Chagford by improving waiting and parking restrictions within the area. It focuses on enhancing the current traffic order layout and introducing new restrictions where necessary, with the goal of improving parking infrastructure for both residents and visitors.

Specifically, the restrictions are proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, will facilitate the passage on the road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) and will preserve or improve the amenities of the area which the road runs through.
