

**Devon County Council (Crannaford Lane, Cranbrook)
(Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order**

Devon County Council make this order in exercise of powers under sections 1, 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers

1. This order comes into force _____ and may be cited as “Devon County Council (Crannaford Lane, Cranbrook) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order _____”
2. Except as provided in article 3 no person shall cause or permit a motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the schedule
3. Nothing in article 2 shall make it unlawful for a motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the schedule if the vehicle is
 - a. an emergency service vehicle being used in an emergency
 - b. being used in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - c. being used in connection with the carrying out on those lengths of road
 - (i) the maintenance, improvement, or reconstruction of the road
 - (ii) the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in, or land adjacent to the road, of a sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity, or the electronic communications network as defined in section 32 of the Communications Act 2003
